

**Attachment 1: CPI ASC Signal Division, Inc. Request for Waiver of 47 C.F.R. § 5.59(a)(2)**

Pursuant to FCC Rule 1.3, 47 C.F.R. § 1.3, CPI ASC Signal Division, Inc. (“CPI”) respectfully requests waiver of the 60-day prior filing requirement of FCC Rule 5.59(a)(2), 47 C.F.R. § 5.59(a)(2), for the instant renewal of Call Sign WE2XDF (the “License”).

Kratos Defense & Security Solutions, Inc. (“Kratos”) completed its acquisition of CPI on June 30, 2020.<sup>1</sup> Due to administrative oversight of the prior controlling entity, the renewal application was not timely filed. However, within two days of acquiring CPI, Kratos has facilitated the filing of the instant application more than four weeks before the License’s expiration.

The Commission has authority to waive its rules “for good cause shown.”<sup>2</sup> Good cause exists for waiver here. Grant of the requested waiver would serve the public interest by allowing CPI to continue uninterrupted testing of its radio equipment enabled the License.
