Special Conditions:

- (1) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) All customers participating in the experiment shall be informed that this operation is for experimental purposes only and can be cancelled at any time.
- (4) Licensee is required to file a PROGRESS REPORT every 6 months from the date of grant. This progress report shall be filed with Federal Communications Commission; Experimental Licensing Branch, MS 1300E1; 445 12 Street, S.W.; Washington, DC 20554 or uploaded electronically via the OET Experimental Licensing Branch's Electronic Filing Web Site at https://gulfoss2.fcc.gov/prod/oet/index_els.html by using the "Add Attachments" feature.
- (5) The PROGRESS REPORT should include, but is not limited to, a description of measurements and results demonstrating compliance with Part 15.109.
- (6) Market study testing is authorized with the use of up to 300 units in Ohio, 300 units in Indiana and 300 units in Maryland.
- (7) CISPR quasi-peak measurements are to be taken in the linear mode only.
