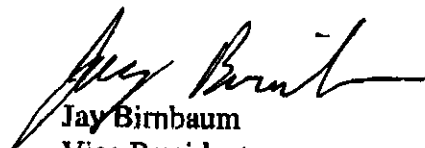
Re: Request for Confidentiality of application and modified license

Dear Mr. Burtle:

Pursuant to Section 0.459 and 0.457(d)(2) of the Commission's Rules, 47 CFR 0.459 and 47 CFR 0.457(d)(2), Current Technologies, LLC (Current) respectfully requests that the information contained in the Exhibit attached to OET File Number 0046-EX-ML-2002 as well as resulting details provided in a modified license, to the extent described below, be afforded confidential treatment and be withheld from public inspection.

Specifically, Current respectfully requests that the radiated emissions levels and limited frequencies that are sought in this modification application be afforded confidential treatment. Current does not seek confidential treatment for the modification in the number of authorized units. The information contains trade secrets as well as commercial and technical data that would customarily be guarded from competitors. Indeed, the very limited modification applied for herein is tailored to focus upon certain emission attributes that Current believes can be harnessed to promote successful development of new technology. However, public disclosure of the radiated emissions levels and limited frequencies sought in the request for modification could render the pioneering research of Current a nullity as the operative part of its technological advancements would no longer be a trade secret.
