Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) Prior to equipment authorization or a determination of compliance, the device must be accompanied by a conspicuous notice worded as follows: "This device has not been authorized as required by the rules of the Federal Communications Commission. This device is not, and may not be, offered for sale or lease, or sold or leased, until authorization is obtained."
- (5) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by the U.S. Air Force contract number F19628-97-D-0038. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (6) Use of this frequency or band under the authority of this assignment is subject to further coordination with HQ USAF frequency coordinator Alexandria, VA, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (7) Use of this frequency or band under the authority of this assignment is subject to further coordination with the FAA New England frequency coordinator Burlington, MA, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (8) Operations shall comply with technical parameters adopted by FCC waiver January 25, 2007.
