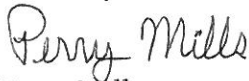
Re: Request of Confidentiality – Experimental License Exhibit

Pursuant to Sections 0.457 (d)(1)(ii) and 0.459 of the Commission's Rules, Data Sciences International (DSI) hereby requests confidential treatment of Exhibit A: Experimentation Description and Exhibit B: Directional Antenna Information submitted in the application for experimental license. Reasons and facts regarding this request follow per 47 CFR 0.459 (b):

- (1) Identification of the specific information for which confidential treatment is sought: Exhibit A: Experimentation Description and Exhibit B: Directional Antenna Information
- (2) Identification of the Commission proceeding in which the information was submitted or a description of the circumstances giving rise to the submission: DSI's application for an Experimental License Form 442 File Number 0034-EX-PL-2012
- (3) Explanation of the degree to which the information is commercial or financial, or contains a trade secret or is privileged: The information identified includes commercial and trade secret content.
- (4) Explanation of the degree to which the information concerns a service that is subject to competition: The information identified concerns the development of a biomedical telemetry system to be used by commercial enterprises such as pharmaceutical companies. There are a number of US and international competitors providing similar services. Developing products for this service involves a substantial degree of financial investment and risk.
- (5) Explanation of how the disclosure of the information could result in substantial competitive harm: Disclosure of the information will inform competitors of technology we intend to employ to address a competitive market.

- (6) Identification of any measures taken by the submitting party to prevent unauthorized disclosure: The information identified has been held DSI-confidential except for limited disclosure to select parties under Non-Disclosure Agreements.
- (7) Identification of whether the information is available to the public and the extent of any previous disclosure of the information to third parties: The information identified has not been made public and has only been made available to select customers under Non-Disclosure Agreements.
- (8) Justification of the period during which the submitting part asserts that material should not be available for public disclosure: DSI requests that the information identified be withheld from public disclosure until 9/1/2012 to allow time for product testing and market release.
