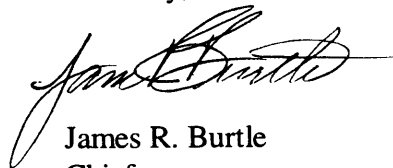
Dear PHILIP J. MASTERS,
