Dear FCC:

Dawson Construction Company of Bellingham Washington will be building the Yana River Fish Hatchery, in the Magadan Province of Russia, for a Magadan - Nikkeiren Joint Venture. The proposed building time will begin in April of 1994 and will continue until October of 1994.

In order to receive and maintain optimum communication throughout the project, Dawson Construction intends to set up a multi-channel, Inmarsat-B system at the jobsite near Tauisk of the Magadan Province. The Inmarsat-B system would enable dependable and efficient communication which otherwise is impossible to conduct; between the jobsite in Russia, Dawson Construction Co. headquarters in Bellingham, Washington, business associates as related to the project, and an essential link to our families in the United States.

This terminal will be used in Russia throughout the construction of the hatchery. At that time there is a possibility that the terminal will be returned to the U.S.
