Below are responses to your recent questions and what steps to take to try to get this application approved:

Is the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau able to provide a listing of any FSS receive stations that are in the vicinity of the location where we plan to operate?

The International Bureau published a list earlier this week. They can use this list (<https://docs.fcc.gov/public/attachments/DA-20-823A2.xls>) to coordinate or they can work with a third party coordinator.

Is the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau able to suggest any modifications to the frequency range in our application that will avoid interference with existing FSS stations?

If it is feasible for them to limit operations to the 4.0-4.2 GHz band, that would be best.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of August 11, 2020 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
