Dear Dan Ehrenhalt,

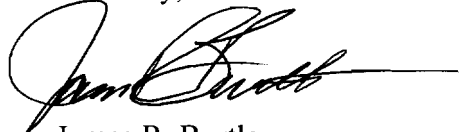
This refers to application, File No. 0019-EX-PL-2006, for Experimental Radio Station WD2XXS.

The enclosed authorization shall be considered as a grant of the referenced application unless rejected by a written notice within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter, whereupon the enclosed grant will be vacated. Such rejection should include a statement of the reasons, if any, why the applicant believes that the application should be granted in accordance with the terms requested therein.

You are advised that the Commission was unable to make a finding that the public interest would be served by a grant of the application in the manner requested. The frequencies 1000-1100 MHz and 5000-5100 MHz were tabled by the FAA during agency coordination procedures. If you still wish to operate on these bands, the FAA requires that you prior coordinate with their regional office. After you complete the regional coordination, you may file a modification to add those frequencies to the license.
