By the instant request (“Application”), DRS ICAS, LLC (“DRS ICAS”) requests that the Commission grant to DRS ICAS a two year experimental license to operate the facilities (the “Facilities”) specified in the instant application. DRS ICAS is a Limited Liability Company.

DRS ICAS is an industry leader in the design, development and production of products and systems for Communications Intelligence (COMINT), Spectrum Management, Satellite Communications and Tactical Military Networks. The testing specified in the instant Application is a critical part of the manufacture and delivery of military systems provided to the Armed Forces in support of Homeland Security as well as war efforts.

The instant Application seeks consent for continuation of the transmissions previously authorized under File No. 0401-EX-ST-2012 (WF9XSH). Specific information regarding the nature and purpose of this experiment, and other technical information, is contained in a Confidential Exhibit 3, with such Exhibit subject to a separately-filed Confidentiality Request. Such descriptions demonstrate that STA is justified pursuant to 5.3(d) and 5.3(f) of the Commission’s rules.

FAA notification is not required pursuant to Section 17.14(a) of the Commission’s rules because the proposed antennas locations are located with existing structures of equal or greater height.
