Exemption from fees:

DuPage Public safety Communications, (Du-Comm), is an association of units of local governments, as they are defined in Article VII, Section 1, of the Constitution of State of Illinois, 1970, and a "public Agency" as defined in the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/2 (1), that is voluntarily established by its members pursuant to Article VII, Section 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 et seq.

As such, Du-Comm is exempt from Filing Fees under: Title 47 CFR Part 1, Subpart G, §1.1162(b):

Title 47 CFR Part 1, Subpart G—Schedule of Statutory Charges and Procedures for Payment**§1.1162 General exemptions from regulatory fees.**

b) Applicants, permittees, or licensees who qualify as government entities. For purposes of this exemption, a government entity is defined as any state, possession, city, county, town, village, municipal corporation, or similar political organization or subpart thereof controlled by publicly elected or duly appointed public officials exercising sovereign direction and control over their respective communities or programs.
