In reply to the above-referenced inquiry, please note the following:

- The datalink equipment that is the subject of this experimental license is being used as part of a larger test and evaluation activity associated with various other technology being developed and integrated to counter the proliferation of small, unmanned aircraft systems (UASs) under the DARPA Mobile Force Protection (MFP) program. This experimental license is not explicitly concerned with the datalink equipment itself – the datalink is a command and control link that is only one small part of the overall MFP system. The datalink is only one technology necessary to develop and demonstrate the feasibility of a prototype system being developed for the DARPA Mobile Force Protection (MFP) contract. Therefore, this experimental license is an enabler to test and evaluate the overall MFP system.

- The specific datalink identified on the application may not be a part of the final system if the Government continues this program beyond the current phase. Thus, this experimental license is not intended, nor will it be used, to be used to market and sell the specific datalink equipment.
