The nationwide experimental license is used by E.F. Johnson Company to continue research and development effort into radio products for the United States market. This involves occasionally setting up stations in various locations for evaluation in various geographic conditions. In addition, beta testing of product is sometimes done at various locations within the country, often at various customer sites. Often it is desirable to set up these tests in short order, usually on a shorter-term basis than applying for individual licenses would allow. The nature of this testing is of a short term, and always subject to non-interference with existing communication systems.

Normal two-way communications pertaining to sales and service of our equipment will not be done on this system.
