Re: Permission for temporary use of 700 MHz channels for purpose of low power demonstrations at
APCO 2007 in Baltimore August 5 through August 8, 2007

Dear Mr. McClellan:

The State of Maryland is pleased to allow EADS Secure Networks temporary low power use of three
(3) channel pairs in the Maryland Public Safety Spectrum, 700 MHz State License - WPTZ805.

The following conditions of use apply:

1. Effective isotropic radiated power (EIRP) will not exceed 1 watt EIRP from the base stations and mobiles/handhelds.
2. Should any harmful interference be detected or reported, EADS is to immediately cease operations.
 - a. The State of Maryland understands that you (Roy McClellan) are the central point of contact for the duration of the show and may be reached at mobile #214-228-0322.
3. EADS will coordinate with any other users performing similar demonstrations at APCO 2007 in Baltimore.
4. The demonstration is to be contained within the confines of the Baltimore Convention Center located at 1 West Pratt Street, Baltimore, MD 21201.
5. The demonstrations may start on 8:00 a.m. EDT, Sunday, August 5, 2007, and will cease by 5:00 p.m. EDT, Wednesday, August 8, 2007.
 - a. The State of Maryland understands the planned demonstrations occur at the APCO Presentation Theater 2 (PT2), Session I Monday, August 6th from 3:30 to 4:30 PM and Session II Tuesday, August 7th from 2:30 to 3:30 PM.
 - b. The State of Maryland understands that there may be a few additional demonstrations that occur during the APCO 2007 Trade Show exhibitor support hours of:

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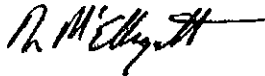
