Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent acts, and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions and requirements set forth in this license, the licensee hereof is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting facilities hereinafter described for radio communications in accordance with the program of experimentation described by the licensee in its application for license.

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Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Per request from Mobility Division/WTB, prior to commencing any operations in the 1850-1910 MHz and 1930-1990 MHz bands, Electro-Voice Dynacord LLC must obtain consent from Broadband PCS licensees (1850-1910 MHz/1930-1990 MHz) within 50 miles of the contours of the testing area.
- (3) Per request from Mobility Division/ WTB, prior to commencing any operations in the 1910-1915 MHz and 1990-1995 MHz bands, Electro-Voice Dynacord LLC must obtain consent from T-Mobile, the licensee in this band.
- (4) Electro-Voice Dynacord LLC must notify the Advanced Wireless Service licensees in the proposed areas prior to conducting experimental operations.

- (6) Electro-Voice Dynacord LLC must operate on a secondary, non-interference basis, and this authorization will be terminated immediately if any interference occurs.
