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Necessary Bandwidth Calculation

The necessary bandwidth was determined using the equation in Annex J of the NTIA Manual¹ for FM-CW radars (see Equation 1). The ELTA EL/M-2112 emission has a maximum frequency deviation of 25 MHz. Applying this frequency to Equation 1 yields a necessary bandwidth of 50 MHz.

$$B_n = 2B_d \quad (1)$$

where

B_n = necessary bandwidth, MHz
 B_d = frequency deviation bandwidth (peak difference between modulated wave instantaneous frequency and carrier frequency for FM/CW radar systems, MHz)
