This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

- (4) Airborne operations by mobile stations in any portion of the frequency band 2290-2300 MHz shall be prohibited
- (5) All transmissions in the 2290-2305 MHz band shall be limited to an Effective Radiated Power (ERP) of 100 milliwatts.
- (6) Operation is not permitted on the frequency band 2200-2900 MHz.
