- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee may not operate in the requested 2265-2285 MHz band due to potential interference with ongoing federal operations in the requested area.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that the band 2200-2290 MHz is allocated for federal operations and is an extremely congested band. Successful coordination is often extremely difficult to achieve, and non-federal use is on a case-by-case basis. NTIA recommends future similar submissions consider requesting the 3450-3600 MHz band.
