- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (5) Any operation in 2450-2483.5 MHz must be coordinated with the existing and future Fixed Microwave Service licensees.
- (6) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by the U.S. Government; contract number 2010-IJ-CX-K023. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.

- (8) Operation must be prior coordinated and approved by 4940-4990 MHz public safety licensees within 50 miles of proposed location.
