



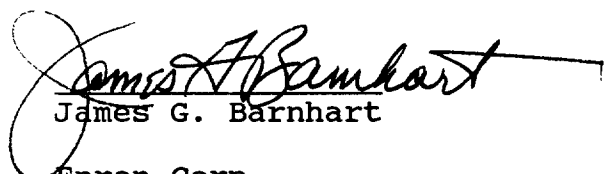

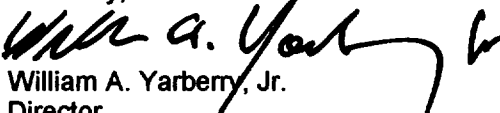
The parties referenced in the attached document have left Enron and we are unsure about the nature of the application.
