Pursuant to the conditions set forth in the above-referenced authorization, this letter will serve as the ninth Experimental Report of Ericsson Business Communications, Inc. ("Ericsson") for Experimental License KF2XEF.

On May 17, 1993 the Commission granted a request of Ericsson Business Communications, Inc. to modify the above-referenced license to utilize the 1850-1990 MHz band at a maximum authorized power of 250 milliwatts. At this point in time, Ericsson Business Communications, Inc. is in the process of deploying a number of experimental systems to gauge the ability of systems using DECT technology in the 1850-1910 MHz band to co-exist with fixed microwave licensees. Inasmuch as the license modification was only recently granted, Ericsson Business Communications, Inc. has no systems deployed at this time.
