Ericsson GE Mobile Communications Inc. is in the process of completing the design and development of a new Master III Station under model #AXATR-197-B2. The station is not currently type approved, however, type approval is due to be submitted to the Columbia Lab sometime during the month of January 1991.

Ericsson GE Mobile Communications Inc. is hereby respectfully requesting the FCC to issue Special Temporary Authority in accordance with FCC Rules 5.56 to conduct a field strength survey for a period of 60 days effective February 1, 1991 through March 31, 1991 for the purpose of testing the new radios in a realistic user environment.

The test will be conducted within a 50 mile radius of New York, NY with one radio operating at 110 watts output power utilizing emission designator 16KOF3E. Frequencies requested are: 159.630 and 160.080 MHz.

Authority and responsibility for the proper operation of this transmitter will be assigned to Ericsson GE Mobile Communications, Inc. Ericsson GE Mobile Communications Inc. further agrees to assume this responsibility to ensure operations will be in full compliance with FCC Rules and Regulations.

The facilities of Experimental Radio Station KE2XFM will be used operating on the frequency band of 150 MHz specified under Part 90 of the FCC Rules subject to the condition that no harmful interference will be caused to any licensed operation.

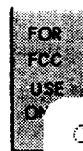
