This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Temporary Authority is hereby granted to operate the apparatus described below:

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Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.

Special Conditions:

- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) Licensee should conduct prior coordination with the Fixed Microwave Service licensees in accordance with 47 CFR, Part 101.103(d).

Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.

Licensee must avoid pointing the transmitting antenna main beam gain within 10 degrees of any point on the geostationary orbital arc while transmitting signals in the 27.699-27.701 GHz 38.999-39.001 GHz bands.

Licensee shall ensure that the transmitting fixed station antenna main beam gain tip down when possible and avoid pointing above the horizon to protect satellite stations
