 - a. Secure consents from the Advance Wireless Service licensees prior to accessing to 2110-2170 MHz band.
 - b. Coordinate with the affected Fixed Microwave Service licensees in accordance with 47 C.F.R, Part 101.103(d) prior to operation in 27500-28350 MHz band.
- (4) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
