The purpose of this letter is to provide a report in accordance with the Consensus Plan, referred to in the Exelon Generation Company, LLC (EGC) Experimental License Application and also filed in ET Docket No. 05-345 on May 15, 2007 by the Nuclear Energy Institute and the Utilities Telecom Council in their Supplement to Petition for Waiver.

Specifically, in accordance with Section IV, "Licensing and Reporting Requirements," paragraph D of the Consensus Plan, EGC confirms that the subject nuclear stations have engaged in local frequency coordination, to the extent required, and limited the use of the Telex Equipment at these nuclear station locations to only those circumstances permitted under the Consensus Plan. Further, the subject nuclear stations have operated in compliance with the Special Conditions set forth on Licenses 0498-EX-PL-2007 and 0445-EX-PL-2007.
