## STATEMENT OF INTENDED USE OF A TRANSPORTABLE LAND-BASED INMARSAT TERMINAL

Esso Exploration, an affiliate of Exxon Communications Company, regularly explores for petroleum worldwide in very remote areas not served by common carriers. Such areas include the Rocky Mountains in the Lower 48 and the North Slope of Alaska. Exxon has a need for adequate and reliable communications for the safety of the personnel involved.

The portable INMARSAT terminal will be used at temporary locations within the Continental United States, including Alaska, for voice and data communications from remote areas where no other adequate means of communications are available.
