STATEMENT OF INTENDED USE OF A
TRANSPORTABLE LAND-BASED INMARSAT TERMINAL

Exxon Company, International, an affiliate of Exxon Communications Company, has set up a response team of personnel and equipment which will be rapidly deployed in the event of a hurricane or oil related emergency. The response team will coordinate the emergency operations and will require instant and reliable communications. The portable INMARSAT terminal will be used for voice and data communications from remote areas where no other adequate means of communications are available at temporary locations within the Continental United States, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands during the early coordination of an emergency situation.
