This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) F2 Labs must prior coordination with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers coordinator prior to operation to protect the Low Power Broadcast Auxiliary operations on 80.0 MHz to 698.0 MHz.
- (4) F2 Labs must notch the following frequencies to protect aeronautical flight safety in the area.
412.9375 MHz +/- 12.5 KHz
413.0375 MHz +/- 12.5 KHz
413.1375 MHz +/- 12.5 KHz
- (5) The following frequencies must be notched to protect National Weather Service operations in the area.
415.85 MHz +/- 12.5KHz
410.70 MHz +/- 25KHz
- (6) F2 Lab must notch 406-406.1MHz band used for EPIRBS, ELT's and PLT's.

ITU Radio Regulations, Appendix 15 prohibits any possible interference within the 406-406.1 frequency range
- (7) The following frequencies must be notched to protect EMS and law enforcement communications in the area.

458.350 MHz +/- 6.25 KHz
458.475 MHz +/- 6.25 KHz
458.575 MHz +/- 6.25 KHz
465.225 MHz +/- 6.25 KHz
465.325 MHz +/- 6.25 KHz
465.425 MHz +/- 6.25 KHz.

- (9) The applicant must obtain "consent" of the following within 50 miles of the test area:
 - oAll 700 MHz licensees (698-758 MHz; 775-788 MHz)
 - oAll Cellular licensees (824-849 MHz/869-894 MHz)
 - oCommercial Air-Ground licensee (849-851 MHz/894-896 MHz)
 - oSMR licensees (809-824 MHz/854-869 MHz)
 - oSMR licensees (896-901 MHz/935-940 MHz)

- (10) The applicant must be "notification" of the following within 50 miles of the test area:
 - oNarrowband PCS licensees (901-902 MHz)
 - oLocation & Monitoring Service licensees (902-928 MHz)
