Experimental License Renewal

Dear Ms. Dortch:

As the Commission records reflect, Fairfield Industries, Inc. has requested renewal of its experimental license, KA2XFC (File No. 0010-EX-RR-2010). Fairfield requests a four-year term for the pending renewal.

Fairfield is engaged in an on-going and extended program of research for oil and gas reserves. Much of this activity takes place in the Gulf of Mexico. The equipment covered by this authorization has been designed and developed by Fairfield, or under its supervision. The license authorized by the Commission helps Fairfield gain a better understanding of RF equipment performance in challenging conditions and, at the same time, helps the national priority for energy independence.

Fairfield's license was last renewed for a term of four years. A four-year renewal reduced burdens on the Commission's staff, as well as on the licensee, and for this reason as well is to be preferred.

Accordingly, Fairfield urges that its pending renewal be granted for four years.
