Fairfield Industries, Inc. hereby requests modification of its experimental license so as to add the frequencies 220.55 MHz and 216.45 MHz.^{1/} These frequencies will be utilized for two additional telecommand units that will permit expansion of Fairfield's seismic telemetry development program. Fairfield currently has two crews operating in the Gulf of Mexico, each utilizing a separate telecommand unit which functions on an existing authorized frequency. Fairfield would like to add additional crews. In order to do so, however, it requires authorization to operate additional telecommand units for those crews on the requested frequencies.

The operational area specified is for the Continental United States with primary focus on the Louisiana Gulf Coast from Sabine Pass on the west to New Orleans on the east. The equipment would be utilized both on and off-shore; on-shore use will be in remote marshes and swamps of Louisiana.

In all other respects the operational parameters of Fairfield's existing license will remain unchanged.
