Submitted herewith on behalf of Final Analysis, Inc. ("Final Analysis") is an Application for Experimental Authorization for a fixed/base ground station to operate in conjunction with other experimental facilities already authorized.

Specifically, in August 1995, Final Analysis was granted a license for an experimental non-voice, non-geostationary orbit mobile satellite system, consisting of the following authorized facilities:

One experimental low earth orbit satellite (Call Sign KS2XCY;
File No. 4682-EX-PL-95);

One fixed Master Ground Station in Logan, Utah (Call Sign KS2XDA;

Up to 350 Remote Mobile Terminals (Call Sign KS2XCZ;

The instant application is for an additional fixed ground station to be located in Lanham, Maryland. This new station will permit Final Analysis to access the satellite a second time, from the east coast, as it passes over the continental U.S. This additional access is made more critical by the significant interest generated in Final Analysis's experimental program

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and the need for Final Analysis to maximize communications with the satellite in the conduct of its experiments.
