

FAA Regional Pre-Coordination Statement

FCC Form 442 – Experimental License Application

Applicant: Firestorm Labs, Inc.

1. Purpose

This statement is provided in response to the FAA Regional Pre-coordination attachment request associated with this FCC Form 442 application.

The requested FCC Part 5 experimental authorization supports the testing and evaluation of Firestorm Labs' unmanned aircraft systems (UAS). The requested radio operations are intended to provide communications necessary for aircraft command and control, telemetry, engineering data collection, and system integration during experimental aircraft testing.

2. Flight Test Operations

Flight operations associated with this application are expected to occur primarily at the Firestorm test area located near Ocotillo Wells, California.

Firestorm Labs anticipates conducting flight operations under applicable FAA operating authority. At the time of this filing, flight operations at the Ocotillo Wells location are expected to be conducted under a Certificate of Authorization (COA) administered through the University of Alaska, or under other applicable FAA approvals as required.

The requested FCC experimental authorization is intended solely to authorize the use of experimental radio equipment and frequencies. Firestorm Labs acknowledges that this authorization does not grant authority to conduct flight operations and does not replace any FAA approvals or operating authorizations that may be required.

3. Ground Test Operations

The Firestorm Labs facility located at 9431 Dowdy Drive, San Diego, California 92126, will be used for laboratory testing, ground integration, engineering development, and equipment checkout. No flight operations are proposed from this location under this application.

4. Coordination

At the time of this application, Firestorm Labs has not separately requested FAA regional spectrum coordination related to this FCC Part 5 application. The applicant will comply
