operating on a paired channel in the 777-792 MHz band with 600
milliwatts ERP.

>The COLT antennas are mounted on a mast extendable to 40 feet above
ground level.

>The actual demo is scheduled for July 16-17. The COLT will arrive on
July 13 for testing.

>This is the same demo that I previously coordinated with you in April
of this year at the San Jose Convention Center.
