OBJECTION

Capstar TX Limited Partnership ("Capstar"), the licensee of KFI(AM), 640 MHz, Los Angeles, California, Facility ID 34425, by its attorneys, hereby submits this Objection to the experimental special temporary authority ("STA"), for call sign WC9XVA, FCC File No. 0649-EX-ST-2004 (the "STA") issued to Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc. ("Fleetwood").

The STA authorizes Fleetwood to conduct experimental tests pertaining to the RF susceptibility of Recreational Vehicles ("RV"), on various frequencies in Riverside, California, between December 13 and December 18, 2004. The range of frequencies are between 10 kHz - 27120 kHz and 33.3 MHz - 18000 MHz. The STA grant specifically lists 640 kHz as one of the test frequencies. KFI(AM) is authorized and operating as a non-directional AM station, broadcasting on 640 kHz.

Capstar objects to the STA authorization of test operation on 640 kHz due to the likelihood that Fleetwood's tests on 640 kHz will cause interference to the reception of KFI(AM)'s signal within KFI's protected service contour. Such interference would likely deprive numerous regular KFI(AM) listeners of broadcast service within KFI(AM)'s protected service contour.

Capstar would not object to an alternative frequency to 640 kHz for experimental testing, such as 620 kHz or 660 kHz.

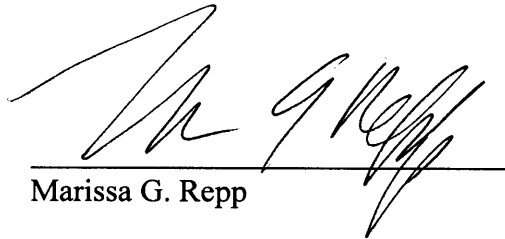
