REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIALITY TREATMENT

To whom it may concern,

In accordance with Section 0.459(b) of the Commission's rule, 47 CFR §0.459(b), Flex Ltd. ("Flex") requests confidentiality treatment of portion(s) of the application for Special Temporary Authority, dated Jul 12, 2017, which is being submitted electronically.

To support the request, the following explanation are provided:

1. Identification of the specific information for which confidentiality treatment is sought:

The information for which confidentiality is sought is the content of Exhibit A.

2. Identification of the Commission proceedings in which the information was submitted or a description of the circumstances giving rise to the submission:

Since the device has not yet been authorized by the FCC, the application submission has been deemed necessary in order to lease the devices to some selected users.

3. Explanation of the degree to which the information is commercial or financial, or contains a trade secret or is privileged:

Flex submitted this application because the information that it contains are of commercial value.

4. Explanation of the degree to which the information concerns a service that is subject to competition:

The information contained in this application if rendered public could cause a commercial damage to Flex.

5. Explanation of how disclosure of the information could result in substantial competitive harm:

Disclosure of the information contained in this application could constitute an advantage for Flex competitors.

6. Identification of any measures taken by the submitting party to prevent unauthorized disclosure:

Confidential material is distributed and circulated only on a need-to-know basis. Furthermore, highly sensitive information is not provided to any third party not bound by confidentiality obligations.

7. Identification of whether the information is available to the public and the extent of any previous disclosure of the information to third parties:

The information contained in this application are not public and they have not been disclosed to any third party not bound by confidentiality obligations.

8. Justification of the period during which the submitting party asserts that material should not be available for public disclosure:

No material marked as confidential in this application is available to the public or third party indefinitely.

9. Any other information that the party seeking confidential treatment believes may be useful in assessing whether its request for confidentiality should be granted:

As mentioned in the previous points, disclosing the information contained in this application could cause a significant commercial damage to Flex, while constituting an advantage to their competitors.
