UNICORN™ Flight Test Area

As noted in Exhibit A hereto, Flight Safety Technologies proposes to operate its UNICORN™ device mounted on an aircraft. The area within which the aircraft will operate is described in this Exhibit B. The area is a rectangular box oriented in an east-west direction beginning about seven miles west of the Cobb County McCollum Field northwest of Atlanta Georgia. The box extends westward for about 18 miles to a point approximately three miles east of Rockmart Georgia. The ends of the box are bounded by 84 degrees, 42 minutes west longitude and 85 degrees, 0 minutes west longitude. The top and bottom of the box are defined by 33 degrees, 59 minutes north latitude and 34 degrees, 1 minute north latitude. The airborne UNICORN™ system will operate entirely within this box at altitudes between the ground and 3,000 feet MSL. As the terrain in this area is mostly around 1,000 feet MSL, Flight Safety will be operating mostly between 1,000 and 2,000 feet above the ground.
