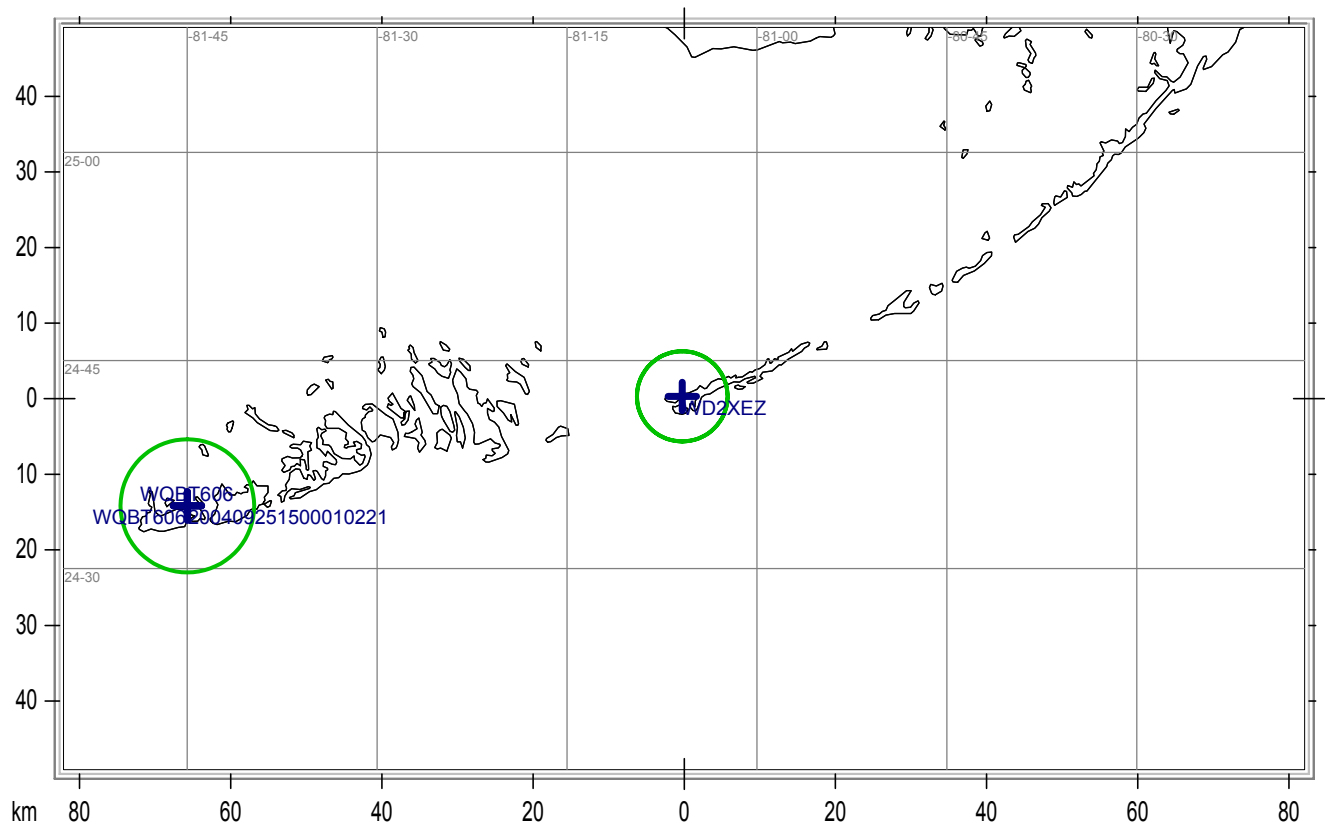
Reference: Renewal of Experimental License WD2XEZ, Frequency 458.5375 MHZ.

As required by FCC to renew your Experimental License WD2XEZ, I did a frequency check of 458.5375. This checked show there is a co channel user 67.5 km away WQBT606, MONROE JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER, Mobile at 40 watts. To evaluate the possibility for interference a 39 dbu Contour Study was perform. This study shows that there is little or no chance of interference between these stations. Attached is copy of this Contour Study.
