Dear Spencer Prows,

This refers to application, File No. 0041-EX-ST-2019, for an experimental authorization.

You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested. The application is dismissed because NTIA objects the request for the following reason(s):

1. Fortem Technologies, Inc. should be aware that concurrence with previous STAs does not guarantee concurrence with current or future submissions.
2. Fortem Technologies, Inc. must treat the functions of Detect-and-Avoid (DAA) and Detect-and-Attack (CUAS not DAA) separately. Fortem Technologies, Inc. must apply for separate grants for each function in this application and split the band accordingly.
3. Fortem Technologies, Inc. should also be aware that the Counter-UAS (CUAS) function may not be approved if it is an active system that engages and jams the intended targets regardless of the band. In order for the CUAS function to be considered it should be passive detection only.
