Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (4) This authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future experimental satellite earth station applications.

Special Conditions:

- (5) Operations are on a non-interference basis (NIB) and shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference and notify the FCC in writing.
- (6) The use for monitoring of airspace and navigation of manned aircraft is unacceptable. The use of this radar for radiolocation is not approved for this band.
- (7) The radar operating in the 15.4-15.7 GHz shall be used for Detect and Avoid (DAA) purposes only. Additional aeronautical radionavigation testing may be allowed under purview of the FAA. However, any function involving the separation of aircraft or nominal Air Traffic Control functions are not allowed, unless explained, coordinated and approved by the FAA on a national level, and meet existing FAA technical and operational standards prior to submit the application to FCC. This radar shall not be used for counter-UAS or perimeter security
