This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Fugro has not provided a STOP Buzzer point of contact, therefore NTIA will utilize Mark Sanford, 301-948-8550, msanford@fugro.com, as point of contact for all interference issues. This point of contact must be available during any and all operations under this Special Temporary Authorization (STA).
- (4) Operation is NOT PERMITTED using the frequency 399-406 MHz.
- (5) The operation overlap the band 406-406.1 MHz will not be permitted.
- (6) AeroSAR - The below frequencies are used for Aircraft Emergency and SAR and must be protected from any possible interference.

- (7) Fugro Geospatial must not utilize the following frequencies due to Safety of Flight concerns for Coast Guard aircraft:

- (10) The following frequencies must not be utilized in order to protect FAA operations in the area:

413.6 MHz and 410.25 MHz (+/-25 kHz).

- (11) Fugro should avoid Annex A channels in 270-328 MHz and 336-390 MHz, per guidance from FCC.
