Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent acts, and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions and requirements set forth in this license, the licensee hereof is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting facilities hereinafter described for radio communications in accordance with the program of experimentation described by the licensee in its application for license.

- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.

Special Conditions:

- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) The applicant must maintain operation separation from the grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90, Subpart Z, or coordinate an agreement with the grandfathered earth station licensees.
- (5) The applicant must ensure that the operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band, and notify the registered users in the proposed geographic area.
- (6) The applicant must be aware that FSS earth stations are licensed on the 3700-4200 frequency band and if any interference occurs, the experimental licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (7) Prior to the start of operations in the 3550 -3700 MHz band, Fujitsu Network Communications must notify by email all the earth stations within 30 km of CBRS small cell transmitters. This notice must include the name and contact information of the stop buzzer personnel in case of interference. The notification should also include the testing parameters and the day and times of each test. Consult MyIBFS database to identify all existing registered earth stations in band (3550-3700 MHz) and adjacent band (3700-4200 MHz).
- (8) Transmitters must comply with earth station protection requirements established in 47 C.F.R. §96.17 (a) and 47 C.F.R. §96.17 (f).
- (9) Ensure that the transmitting base station antenna(s) tip down when possible and avoid point towards the horizon in order to protect satellite earth stations nearby.
- (10) All of the experimental devices will be under the control of Fujitsu Network Communications.
- (11) Operations shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference and notify the FCC in writing.
- (12) Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this license is solely at Fujitsu Network Communication's risk.
