Experimental Radio Station KA2XUK is currently licensed to a site in West Creek, Ocean County, New Jersey. The site is being sold and this modification application seeks to accomplish two purposes:

1. To move KA2XUK to another site, located in Huntington Township, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania.
2. To add the 135.7 to 137.8 kHz band to the authorized frequencies.

The purpose of this radio station is to study propagation and short antenna systems on the 160-190 kHz band (currently authorized under the KA2XUK license) and the 135.7 to 137.8 kHz band (currently proposed or actually authorized as an amateur radio band in a number of countries, especially in Europe).
