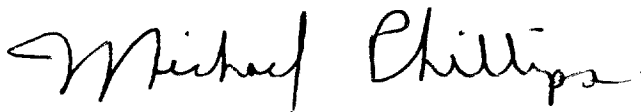
Galleon Wireless is seeking a temporary experimental license from the Federal Communications Commission in order to test and demonstrate our LMDS products.

Galleon is requesting two (2) blocks of 250MHz of bandwidth. These blocks are: (a) 24.350 to 24.600GHz and (b) 26.350 to 26.600GHz. The specific reason that Galleon wishes to test at these frequencies is that Galleon is marketing a broadband wireless product for Uruguay for these frequencies. Hence, our product is for export and the testing is only of a temporary nature. This license will be used at our facility in Milpitas, California.
