1. There are no emission and bandwidth data present in the application. Return to our electronic filing system and use the "Amend/Complete Application" filing option to enter these data. You can use Parts 2.201 and 2.202 of the FCC's rules for guidance.
2. Submit a narrative statement describing in detail the program of research and experimentation proposed, the specific objectives sought to be accomplished; and how the program of experimentation has a reasonable promise of contribution to the development, extension, or expansion, or utilization of the radio art, or is along lines not already investigated.
3. This application looks very similar to another application you just filed, file number 0180-EX-PL-2007. Explain the difference or request withdrawal of one of the applications.
4. You have an exhibit that is marked "confidential," but there is nothing describing what is to be withheld from the public, nor a justification for the confidentiality request. Your justification must be an item-by-item document answering the nine items in Part 0.459(b) of the FCC's rules.
5. You have two antenna locations listed with the same coordinate; the second one has no frequency data. Explain.
6. In order to process your application further, NTIA requires the FCC to forward documentation from the applicant showing compliance with Section 8.3.28 of the NTIA Manual. Submit this documentation as an attachment to this filing.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of April 12, 2007 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
