

GA-ASI will potentially stand up a training academy in Grand Forks, ND starting in January of 2016 in order to meet growing aircrew training requirements for Unmanned Aircraft Systems. We plan to conduct training in support of current and future U.S. Government contracted flight activities. As such, we will need to fly in the surrounding airspace near Grand Forks using Radio Line of Sight (RLOS) frequencies and Beyond Radio Line of Sight (BRLOS) frequencies using Satellite Communications (SATCOM). We plan to fly several aircraft (mix of Pred A and B variants) from the Grand Skies Development Corporation location and utilize the Grand Forks AFB runway. One or more of the aircraft will likely be permanently based there. Frequencies on our current FCC license will be applicable to the new geographic location of Grand Forks, ND.
