NAME General Atomics

This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

- (3) General Atomics must coordinate with Yuma Proving Grounds SMO at 928-328-7144 at least 14 days prior to operations within 80km of YPG.
- (4) General Atomics must coordinate with DOD Western Area Frequency Coordinator, 760-939-6832, jamie.heaton@navy.mil, 72 hours prior to operations for coordination/deconfliction and provide a current stop buzzer contact name and phone number in the event that interference is encountered.
- (5) Prior to commencing any operations in Aeronautical and Fixed frequencies (2360-2395 MHz), the applicant must coordinate with the Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council (AFTRCC).
