Dear Mr. Ryan Peterson:

Prior coordination with the 2 CARS licensees as listed below is required for operations in Ann Arbor, Ypsilanti, Grass Lake, and South Lyon, MI areas [75km (46.605 miles) centered around 42-18-13N and 83-41-50W]. The intended experiments, even performed infrequently, have a potential to interfere with these existing stations. In addition, the application lacks an analysis to show coordination among the operators for the use of the affected frequencies. Cable television is a 24/7 service so intermittent disruptions could adversely affect the service.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application.
