1. A more detailed description of the experiment is necessary.
2. You state that you are performing military testing, but 161 MHz and 162 MHz are allocated to non-Federal government users only. Explain.
3. You have entered a bandwidth equal to the operating frequency for each frequency you have requested. This does not seem to make sense. Consult with Part 2.202 of the FCC's rules for explanation of bandwidth determination.
4. You have requested a start date that is only four days after the filing date. This is not enough time for us to coordinate use of your frequencies. Suggest a more reasonable start date.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of May 28, 2009 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
