Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) The applicant must coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineer frequency coordinator prior to operation in/on 40-74.62 MHz, 80.3 MHz, 169.188 MHz, 432-465 MHz, and 635-668 MHz frequencies/bands.
- (3) The applicant must obtain consents from Educational Broadband Service licensees prior to accessing to 2684 MHz.
- (4) Prior to commencing any operations, the applicant must obtain consent from the following within 50 miles of the contours of the testing area:
 - Paging Service licensees in 43 MHz
 - AMTS Licensee (217-218 MHz/219-220 MHz)
 - Paging Service licensees in 454 MHz/459 MHz
 - General Aviation Air-Ground Service in 454 MHz/459 MHz
 - Commercial Air-Ground licensee (849-851 MHz/894-896 MHz)
- (5) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (6) The authorized station must be in compliance with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requirements as set forth in Section 17.4 of the Commission's Rules.
- (7) The authorized station must be in compliance with environmental requirement set forth in Section 1.1307 of the Commission's Rules.

Special Conditions:

- (8) This authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future experimental satellite earth station applications.
- (9) Operations are on a non-interference basis (NIB) and shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference and notify the FCC in writing.
- (10) Operation is NOT permitted using the frequency 25 MHz and 1408 MHz.
