

Statement as to Assignee

General Electric Company (GE) is engaged in developing, manufacturing and marketing a wide variety of products for the generation, transmission, distribution, control and utilization of electricity and products and services developed from the application of related and new technologies. Through a wholly-owned, non-consolidated affiliate and its two wholly-owned subsidiaries, GE also engages in a broad spectrum of financial services including distribution sales financing, commercial and industrial financing, real estate and reinsurance. In addition, GE has majority or minority interests in a number of financial companies engaged primarily in manufacturing and distributing products and services outside the United States similar to those sold domestically. GE also owns, through subsidiaries, the licenses of fifteen television and radio stations in the United States (See Attachment A), the NBC Television Network, the licenses of various satellite earth stations, mobile radio stations and common carrier authorizations used in the common carrier communications and other business activities of RCA Corporation and its subsidiaries, all of which are a matter of record before the Commission.

An Ownership Report for GE was filed with the Commission on October 16, 1987 in connection with the acquisition of WTVJ(TV), Miami, Florida. That report, which is a matter of

record before the Commission, set for the officers and directors of GE; for convenience, that list is set forth as Attachment B.

Statement re Antitrust
Record of General Electric Company as to
Radio Communications Activities

The entire antitrust record of General Electric Company (GE) prior to 1964 was reviewed and passed on by the Commission in Memorandum Opinion and Order, FCC 64-641, released on July 24, 1964 (2 RR 2d 1038), which is hereby incorporated by reference. The antitrust record of GE during the period from 1964 through 1978 was reviewed and passed on by the Commission in connection with a proposed merger with Cox Broadcasting Corporation (File Nos. BTCTV-790531KV, et al); the GE/Cox merger was approved by the Commission but never consummated. GE's antitrust record from 1979 through March 1980 was passed on by the Commission in granting, without condition, the license renewal (File No. BRCT-791203KD) of Station KCNC-TV; a subsequent renewal application (File No. BRCT-821201VV) was granted by the Commission without condition on March 11, 1983. In February, 1986 GE and RCA (including NBC) submitted applications, which included litigation records for GE and RCA (including NBC) for approval of the merger of GE and RCA. The GE/RCA merger was approved by the Commission in a Memorandum Opinion and Order, FCC 86-285, released on June 6, 1986.

Subsequent to the GE/RCA merger, the Department of Justice expressed concern that the merger might lessen competition in the production and sale of vidicon tubes.

Accordingly, GE completed the divestiture of its vidicon tube business on December 31, 1986 pursuant to the terms of a Final Judgement approved and entered by the Court on December 12, 1986 in United States v. General Electric Company, Civ. No. 86-1578 (D.D.C. 1986).
